

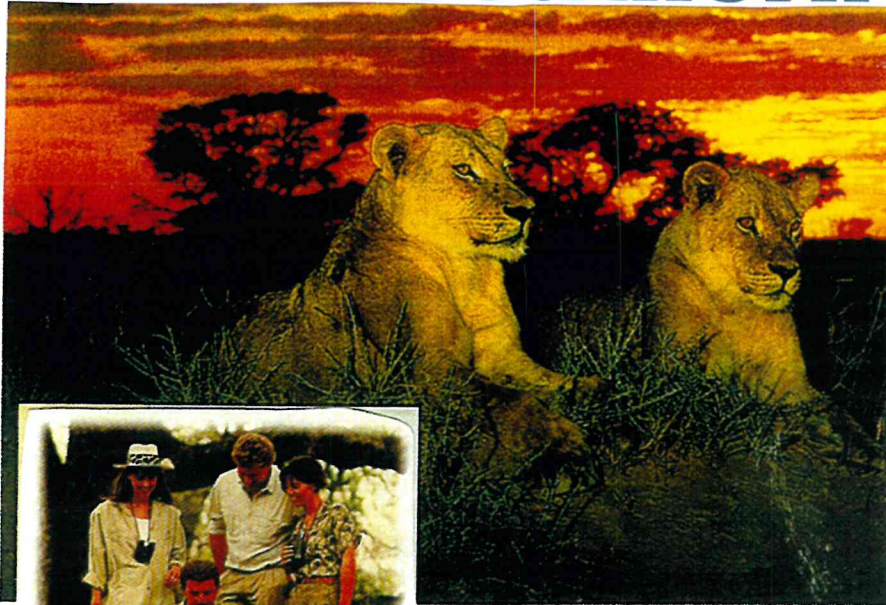

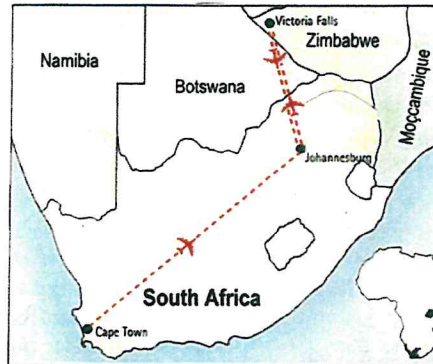

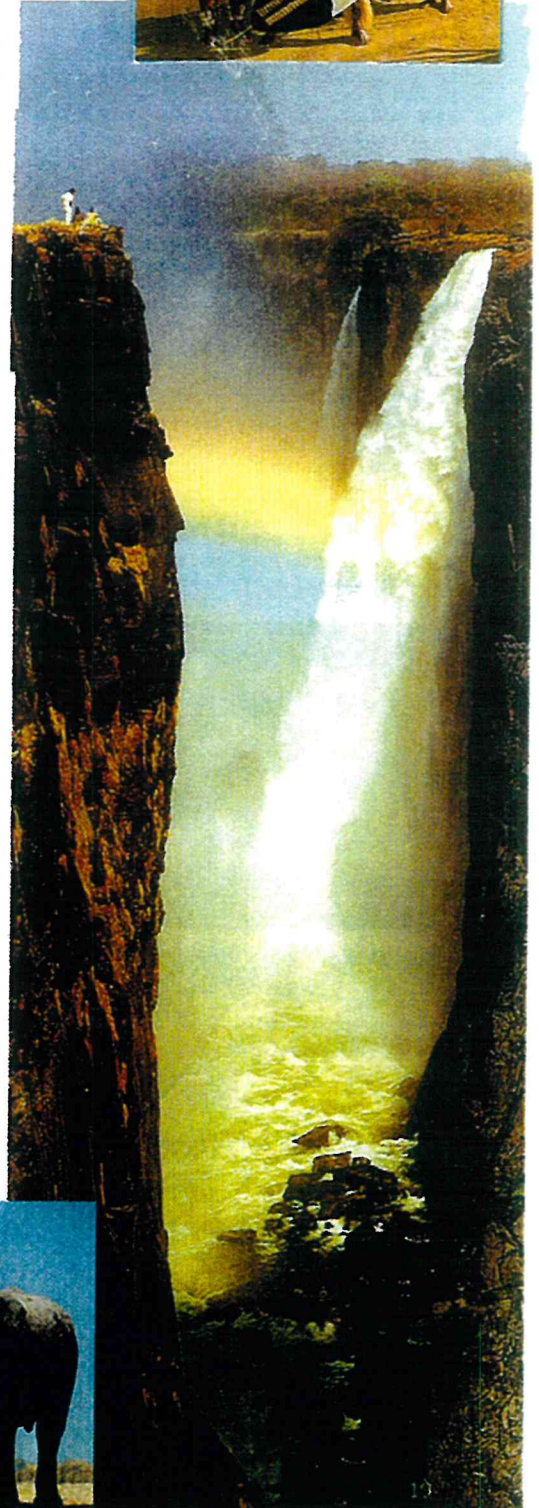


Lovely Cape Town harbor is one of the 7 Natural Wonders of the World. Tour includes a ride to the top of Table Mt.

DAILY ITINERARY

Feb. 10 & 11: Depart Los Angeles Your journey to exotic Africa starts with an evening flight from Los Angeles.

Feb. 12: CAPE TOWN, SOUTH AFRICA. Arrival in Cape Town, South Africa's oldest and most spectacular city. Transfer to your hotel, unpack and relax--rest of the day at leisure. **SUN SQUARE CAPE TOWN CITY BOWL HOTEL**

Feb. 13: CAPE TOWN. On this morning's sightseeing tour, ride by cable car to the top of Table Mountain for glorious city and bay views. Descend and travel through the Malay Quarter for a chance to view and photograph mountain vistas from a distance. Tour ends at the vibrant Victoria & Alfred Waterfront, filled with restaurants and a sprawling mall. (B)

Feb. 14: CAPE TOWN. Full day excursion to Cape Peninsula, where the Atlantic and Indian Oceans meet. Here, admire the views at the Cape of Good Hope Natural Reserve and see baboons, rheboks, zebras, and even penguins at Boulder Beach. After a delicious lunch, continue your journey and tour beautiful Kirstenbosch Botanical Gardens. (B,L)

Feb. 15: CAPE TOWN—Leisure day. Sheltered beneath the familiar shape of Table Mountain, one of the world's Seven Natural Wonders, Cape Town is a perfect city to explore on your own. You may wish to take optional tours to the country's celebrated Winelands or to Robben Island, where former President Nelson Mandela was imprisoned for 18 years. (B)

Feb. 16-18: Today fly to Johannesburg and by private transfer proceed to **BLACK RHINO GAME LODGE** in malaria-free Pilanesberg National Park. The lodge offers spacious accommodations with free WiFi, air-conditioned suites and bathrooms stocked with toiletries. Black Rhino Game Lodge also includes a swimming pool, outdoor dining and features access to a site overlooking an animal watering hole. Daily brunches (following morning safaris) and dinners are included.

Each day features morning and afternoon safaris, conducted both in the Pilanesberg National Park and within the Black Rhino private reserve. The Big Five (lion, leopard, Cape Buffalo, rhino, elephant) are present at both locations. (B,D)

Feb. 19: VICTORIA FALLS, ZIMBABWE. Today, depart Pilanesberg and return to Johannesburg. Fly to Victoria Falls, Zimbabwe. You will be met and assisted to your hotel, which is surrounded by lush gardens and swimming pools. This evening board a boat on the Zambezi River and be served refreshments while taking a private Sundowner Cruise, keeping your eyes open for crocodiles, hippos, and other wildlife! **PIONEERS VICTORIA FALLS LODGE (B)**

Feb. 20: VICTORIA FALLS. At one mile wide stretching from Zimbabwe to Zambia and 360 feet high, Victoria Falls is the largest waterfall in the world and is one of the Seven Natural Wonders of the World. Following the guided tour of the Falls, you will be treated to a two-course lunch at renowned Lookout Cafe. This evening, enjoy a fabulous "Boma" dinner outdoors with native dancers, drumming, and delicious local cuisine. *Enjoy!* (B,L,D)

Feb. 21: VICTORIA FALLS. A free day is yours to return to Victoria Falls, or you may wish to visit the local African village or take a helicopter ride above the Falls, or tour the historic Victoria Falls Hotel. Alternately, A.C.T. is offering an optional full day excursion to the bordering countries of Botswana and Namibia, where you will embark on both a game drive inside Chobe National Park and a boat safari to the Caprivi Strip in Namibia on the Chobe River, cruising waters along the banks of yet another country, Zambia. At dusk, return to your hotel in Zimbabwe. (B)

Feb. 22: VICTORIA FALLS/JOHANNESBURG/DEPART AFRICA. Morning at leisure. This afternoon, transfer to the airport for your flight back to the U.S. (B)
