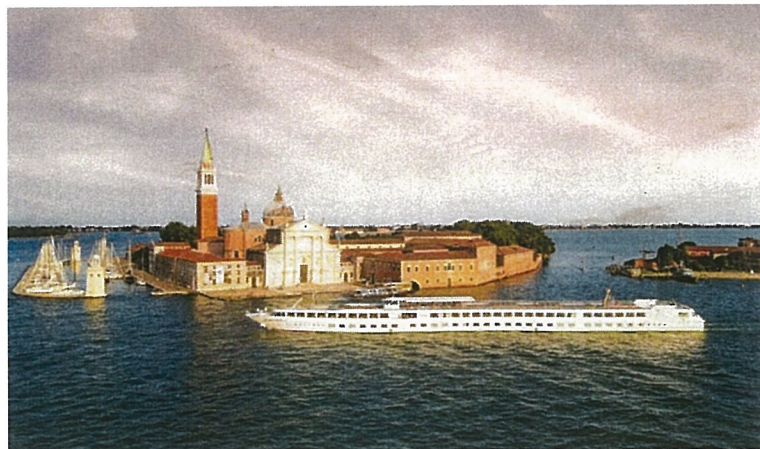

Salzburg, with its broad squares and narrow lanes, is where W.A. Mozart was born and was the setting of "The Sound of Music." A train journey between beauty and serenity takes you to iconic Venice with its remarkable treasures, where your floating hotel, CroisiEurope's intimate ship *MS Michelangelo* is berthed near St. Mark's Square. Onboard meals and beverages are included, as well as port fees and free Wi-Fi.

DAILY ITINERARY

April 19: Depart USA. Fly today from Los Angeles Int'l Airport to Munich, Germany.

April 20: Munich/Salzburg, Austria. After landing and clearing customs, you will transfer by modern motor coach to your centrally-located 1st Class hotel in Salzburg, arriving early-afternoon. Rest of the day at leisure. **HOTEL COCOON SALZBURG**

April 21: Salzburg. Salzburg is situated on the border of Germany, with views of the Eastern Alps. The city is divided by the Salzach River, with medieval and baroque buildings of the pedestrian Altstadt (Old City) on its left bank, facing the 19th-century Neustadt (New City) on its right, where your hotel is situated. This Baroque jewel was the birthplace of Mozart. Today's guided walking tour takes you to view the house where the famous composer was born, as well as to the beautiful squares and gardens of the city, crowned by the 11th century Hohensalzburg Fortress. Salzburg is also known for the singing von Trapp family and is the setting for the film dedicated to them, *The Sound of Music*. (B)

April 22: Salzburg. Day at leisure. Optional tours include visiting sites featured in *The Sound of Music* and a fun tour of the nearby salt mines. Your hotel is just a one-minute walk away from the city's renowned Panorama Restaurant, known for Austrian specialties like *Wienerschnitzel*, Goulash soup, and the town's namesake dessert *Salzburger Nockerl*. (B)

April 23: Salzburg to Venice, Italy by train. Following breakfast, travel from Salzburg to Venice by train—the 207-mile ride is fast and comfortable, with a duration of only four hours. You will depart from the Salzburg rail station located in the heart of town and enjoy the beautiful scenery of the journey before arriving in Venezia Santa Lucia, also located right in the city center. A CroisiEurope boat representative will meet and transfer you from the station to its sleek ship *MS Michelangelo*, moored near Saint Mark's Square. Settle into your stateroom and take in the spectacular view of the City of the Doges! A welcome dinner with your choice of beverages kicks off your stay. Evening at leisure. (B, D)

April 24: Venice. Venice, "La Serenissima," never fails to captivate with its unique atmosphere, winding alleys, iconic canals, and breath-taking architecture. Its lagoon is a mesmerizing blend of land and water, creating a city unlike any other in the world. Vehicles, including buses, are forbidden in the city; on today's guided easy-walking tour, you will visit the Doge's Palace, St. Mark's Cathedral, the Bridge of Sighs, and other famous Venetian landmarks. (B,L,D)

April 25-27: Venice. Three leisure days to explore Venice and its lagoons, which combined have been named an UNESCO World Heritage site. Opt to admire the wonders of the enchanting islands, including Burano, Mazzorbo, and Chioggia, or take a short ferry ride to dreamy Lido Beach on the Adriatic. Sway to evening live classical music performed at San Marcos Square, visit a gondola factory (or take a romantic gondola ride under the Rialto Bridge!), have dinner at Harry's Bar—Hemingway's favorite Italian watering hole—and immerse yourself in many other rich traditions of Italian culture. In addition, on April 27 A.C.T. will offer a day excursion to the oldest country in the world: San Marino, via Bologna. From your "floating hotel," the *MS Michelangelo*, you can explore the wonders of Venice at your own pace! (B,L,D)

April 28: Venice/USA. Your memorable vacation to Salzburg and Venice ends today when you disembark the ship and are transferred to Marco Polo Airport, where you will fly back to Los Angeles arriving the same day. (B)

HOTELS AND LODGES: Per person prices are based on two persons sharing a room with two beds or one queen bed plus private facilities at indicated First Class hotel and ship listed or similar. **Single supplement: \$1295, Main Deck**
