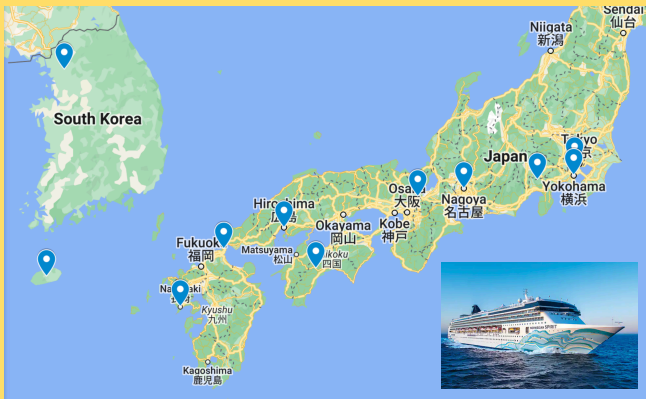

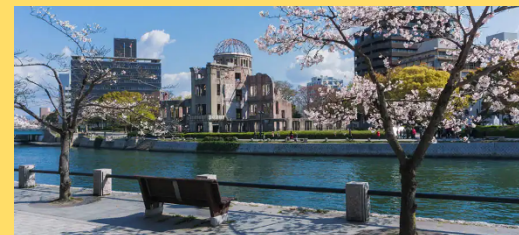

Sept. 1 & 2: Depart U.S.A. Your vacation starts today when you fly to South Korea from Los Angeles Int'l Airport (LAX).

Sept. 2: Seoul, South Korea. Arrive in Korea's capital and transfer to your first class hotel. **NOVOTEL (or similar)**

Sept. 3: Seoul/Cruising. Morning free to relax or opt to take a city tour before being transferred in the afternoon to your ship, the *Norwegian Spirit*. Settle into your stateroom and unpack once for the next 11 days. **Set sail at 4:00 p.m.**

Sept. 4: Jeju Island, South Korea. 9:00 a.m.-5:00 p.m. This fishing port, located on the northern end of Jeju Island, provides a good base for exploring the island's treasures, from **lovely beaches to quaint villages** and more traditional sites like **Kwanumsa, a Buddhist temple founded in 1908 by a woman monk**. Local legend has it that Jeju Island is watched over by the **strange stone sculptures called "tolharubangs,"** squat, ugly figures with bulging eyes made from volcanic rock.

Sept. 5: Nagasaki/Sasebo, Japan. 7:00 a.m.-5:00 p.m. Sasebo, located in Nagasaki Prefecture on Japan's third largest island, Kyushu, is known for **HuisTen Bosch, an amusement park modeled after a Dutch town**, with canals, replica buildings, windmills and flower gardens. **Nagasaki, 40 miles away**, is set on a large natural harbor, with buildings on the terraces of surrounding hills. It is synonymous with a key moment during World War II, after suffering an **Allied nuclear attack in August 1945**. The event is memorialized at the city's **Atomic Bomb Museum and Peace Park**.

Sept. 6: Cruise Kanmon Strait/Beppu, Japan. 9:30 a.m.-5:00 p.m. Enjoy the many amenities aboard your ship as you cruise Kyushu Island's scenic Kanmon Strait to Beppu, famous among travelers for its abundance of **hot springs** and the variety of baths they provide. **Visitors can enjoy traditional hot water baths as well as sand baths, mud baths, and steam baths.**

Sept. 7: Hiroshima, Japan. 7:00 a.m.-5:00 p.m. The city was **built up from five small fishing villages on sandy islands** in the delta of the **Otagawa River**. Hiroshima has been completely rebuilt, except for what is known as the **A-Bomb Dome**, easily viewed from the **Peace Memorial Park** across the river where a variety of monuments commemorate those who died.

Sept. 8: Kochi, Japan. 7:00 a.m.-4:00 p.m. Kochi is home to almost half of the island of Shikoku's population. **Kochi Castle**, a remarkably well-preserved castle from feudal times, sits atop a hill downtown, and remnants of **another castle can be found near Urado Bay**. The city is also home to **Makino Botanical Garden** and **several miles of street markets**.

Sept. 9: Kyoto/Kobe, Japan. 8:00 a.m.-7:00 p.m. The major attractions in the **former capital city of Kyoto** are the **Gold Pavilion, the Honeymoon Shrine and the Hall of the 1,001 Buddhas**. Kobe, renowned for **Kobe beef**, is home to **Christian churches, Shinto and Buddhist temples**, and a fine arts museum with a collection of **Western and Asian works**.

Sept. 10: Nagoya, Japan. 10:30 a.m.-6:30 a.m. **Nagoya is Japan's fourth-largest city**. Opt to visit the **oldest castle in Japan and the Atsuta Jingu Shrine**, one of the emperor's Three Sacred Treasures. **Museums abound, as well.**

Sept. 11: Mount Fuji/Shimizu, Japan. 7:00 a.m.-4:00 p.m. Shimizu is **one of Japan's most beautiful ports** because of nearby **Mt. Fuji and Miho-no-Matsubara, a seashore with beautiful green pine trees and white sands**. In Shimizu you can experience **cultural performances of Geisha dances** and the **Japanese tea ceremony**.

Sept. 12: Yokohama (Tokyo), Japan. 7:00 a.m. An hour from the **port city of Yokohama** is the booming city of Tokyo. A visit to vibrant Tokyo reveals a mix of traditional and modern attractions: See the **Imperial Palace**, participate in a **tea ceremony** or shop in the legendary **Ginza district**. Tours also take passengers to the **Meiji Shrine and the Senso-ji Temple**.

Sept. 13: Tokyo/USA. Morning disembarkation from the *Norwegian Spirit* and transfer to the airport for your flight back to the USA, arriving the same day and ending a most memorable vacation.
